If you have a child turning five (5) on or before 31st July 2021, or you know someone who does, please contact the school to request an enrolment form. By law, all children must be enrolled in school by their sixth birthday.

Please note that 100 points of ID, birth certificate and Medicare version of the child's immunisation statement all form part of the enrolment application.
